



This Week's Icebreaker Question:

Now that it's November, when do you officially start listening to Christmas music?

Sermon Specific Questions:

1. With us being 2 weeks into the Angels & Demons sermon series, what is something that has really stood out to you up to this point? Why is it important for us to see what the Bible has to say about the supernatural?
2. Reading from Genesis 1:26-31 we see that we are made in the image of God. What does that mean? What are the implications of this and why is this significant for our understanding?
3. Genesis 3:1-2 and Revelation 12:9 are a few verses that give a vivid description of Satan being like a serpent. In Ezekiel 28:12-13 and Isaiah 14:12 we also see another description of Satan, described as beautiful and shining. With these passages and the message we heard on Sunday, has the way you pictured the origin of Satan changed? Why would it be important to take time to process who Satan is and how he came about becoming the enemy of our souls?
4. Reading Genesis 2:16-17, we see that God creates us with freewill – we have the choice to obey God or not. With the ability to choose comes the inherent understanding of it's consequences. Why is it important for us to understand our freewill in connection to God and His love for us?
5. How will you go about your week differently since you now have a better understanding that the spiritual realities are the greater realities?
