



Before Service Begins:

- Make sure your Life Group is all watching one of the online services together.
- Communicate to your Life Group how you will connect following the service (Facetime, Facebook Messenger, Zoom, Skype, Google Hangout, etc)
- Grab your Bible and Notebook, and get ready for an amazing service!

Tips for an amazing Welcome Home to Church Online experience:

- Watch the service on your largest screen – *it'll feel more like you're "there"*
- Sing along loud and proud with the worship team
- Lean into the message – *say "amen," clap, shout, use your Bible & take notes*

Sermon Specific Questions:

1. We see in 1 Kings 18:1-2 that the prayer of faith is linked to obedience. How have you seen God move on your behalf when you stepped out in faith and obedience? Why can the journey of faith and obedience be challenging at times, and what can you do now to strengthen your faith in preparation for future steps of obedience?
2. The prayer of faith is based on hearing the inaudible, just like the example we see from Elijah's statement in 1 Kings 18:41. What does 'hearing the inaudible' look like in the life of a Christian? How can this kind of faith impact the lives of those around you?
3. 1 Kings 18:42-45 shows us that the prayer of faith accomplishes the impossible. What seemingly impossible things can we as a Life Group agree with you in prayer about? What are some instances you can share to build other's faith about God doing the impossible in your life?
4. James 5:16-18 references the life of Elijah and his prayers of faith. What sticks out to you from these verses? What are some things you can do this week in order to see these verses ring true in your life, replacing your name with Elijah's in these verses?
