Sermon Specific Questions:

1. The words from Jesus in Luke 17:6 show us that supernatural faith is simple. Why do you think the disciples struggled with how simple supernatural faith actually is? How can we at times make faith more complicated than it should be? How is supernatural faith different than saving faith or serving faith?
2. We also see in Luke 17:6 that supernatural faith speaks. Why do you think we are hesitant at times to speak directly to the mountains that need to be moved in our lives? How is speaking with supernatural faith different than just "name it and claim it" sort of approach to life? Can you share a time where you spoke supernatural words of faith and experienced a miracle?
3. Luke 17:7-10 shows us that supernatural faith is connected to serving. Why is it important to connect the supernatural works of God in our lives to serving others? What are some ways you are currently exercising supernatural faith through serving and submission?
4. We are in our final week of Fasting and Prayer as a church. How has the 21 Days of Fasting and Prayer encouraged your faith and motivated you to see the impossible happen in your life? What are you specifically praying for God to do during the 21 Days of Fasting and Prayer that won't happen otherwise?
