Sermon Specific Questions:

1. Read Psalm 91:1-2. What does it mean for God to be our refuge? What would you say to somebody who doesn't claim that God is his or her refuge?
2. In Psalm 91:1-2 we see 4 names of God written by the psalmist:
 - 1) Most High – *Elyon* [highest or exalted one]
 - 2) Almighty – *Shaddai* [almighty, the mountain one]
 - 3) Lord – *Yahweh* [eternal, covenant keeping God]
 - 4) God – *Elohim* [creator]

How does knowing who God is and what He does build your faith and change your perspective?

3. Reading through Psalm 91:3-6, Psalm 34:7-9, and Proverbs 3:23-26 we see that God will protect and deliver us through dark and difficult seasons. How have you seen God do this in the past, and how does that impact your faith for the future?
4. In verses 9 & 10 of Psalm 91 we see that there is blessing and protection when we make the Lord our “dwelling place.” What does making the Lord your dwelling place look like for you? For your family? What are some ways you are intentional about continually making God your dwelling place and not other things your dwelling place?
5. How will Psalm 91:1-13 prepare you for whatever you may face this week? What are some things you will hold onto from these verses when facing a situation that the enemy may try to use to create anxiety, stress, fear, frustration, etc?
