Sermon Specific Questions:

- 1. What is something that you are really excited about with the *Welcome To The Future* campaign? How have you seen your faith strengthened since the campaign started? What miracles are you believing for through this capital campaign?
- 2. The first point of Pastor's message, "You Can't Out-Give God," was we receive according to what we give. After reading Luke 6:38 and 2 Corinthians 9:6-10, discuss as a group how these verses build your faith when it comes to giving. Knowing that this is a law that is undeniable (in the same way the law of gravity and Newton's laws of motion are), how does this impact the way you give?
- 3. We receive more than we give according to Luke 6:37-38. How have you seen these verses ring true in your personal life or in those around you? Knowing these verses, what are some reasons why we still may struggle at times with being generous?
- 4. The final part of Luke 6:38 shows us that we determine how much we will receive Pastor John says, "We don't give to get, but we do give knowing that we will receive back from the Lord." . How does this impact your faith when it comes to generosity? Can you recall the first time you stepped out in faith in your giving? How has your level of generosity grown since?
